

THIS DOCUMENT IS RELEVANT TO THOSE COMPANIES THAT DID THEIR REACH PRE-REGISTRATIONS ON-LINE DIRECTLY INTO THE REACH-IT SYSTEM. If you did your pre-registration via 'IUCLID5 upload', it is not relevant to you.

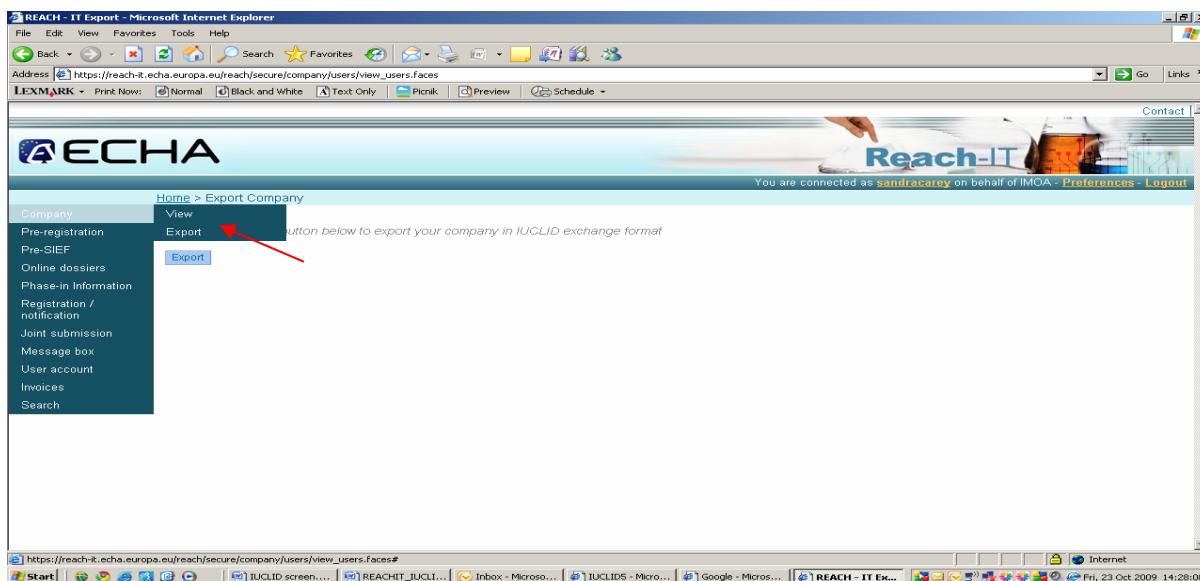
When you originally applied for access to the REACH-IT system, the first thing the system automatically does is create a LEO (Legal Entity Object) for you. This is an electronic file containing the unique identification code of your legal entity, and it is stored within your user section of REACH-IT.

This electronic file needs to be loaded into the IUCLID5 software that you are going to use to prepare your REACH-registration dossier/s, so this documents tells you how to do this.

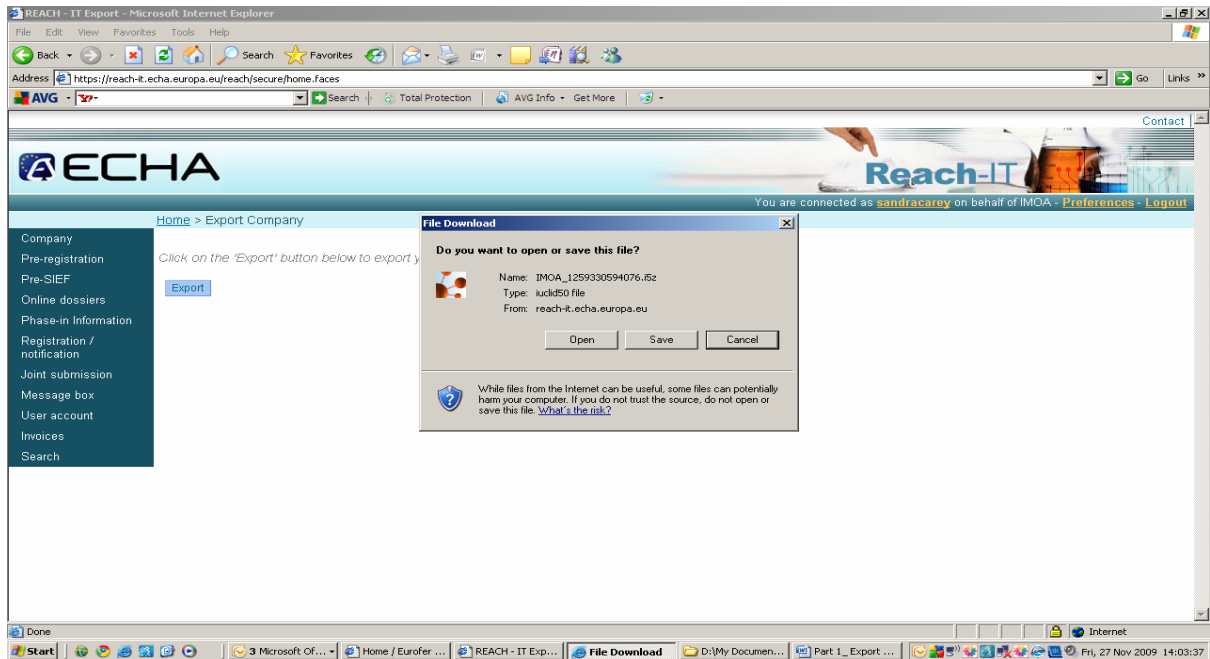
HOW TO **EXPORT** YOUR LEO from REACH-IT into your computer, ready for **IMPORT** to IUCLID5.

To access the REACH-IT system: http://echa.europa.eu/reachit/portal_en.asp

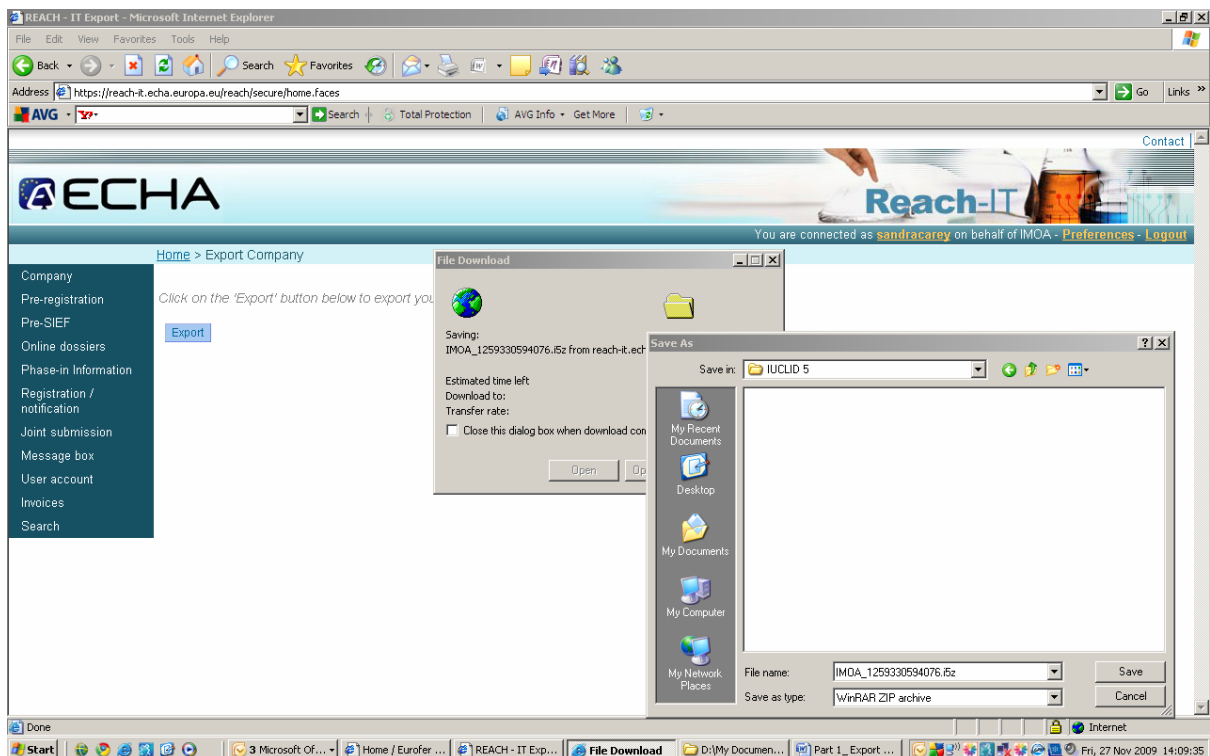
1. **Login** where it says 'The portal can be accessed here
2. **Follow the login instructions** (User ID/password, etc)
3. **Then, from the blue menu on the left handside, select COMPANY, then select EXPORT**
4. **Click on Export**



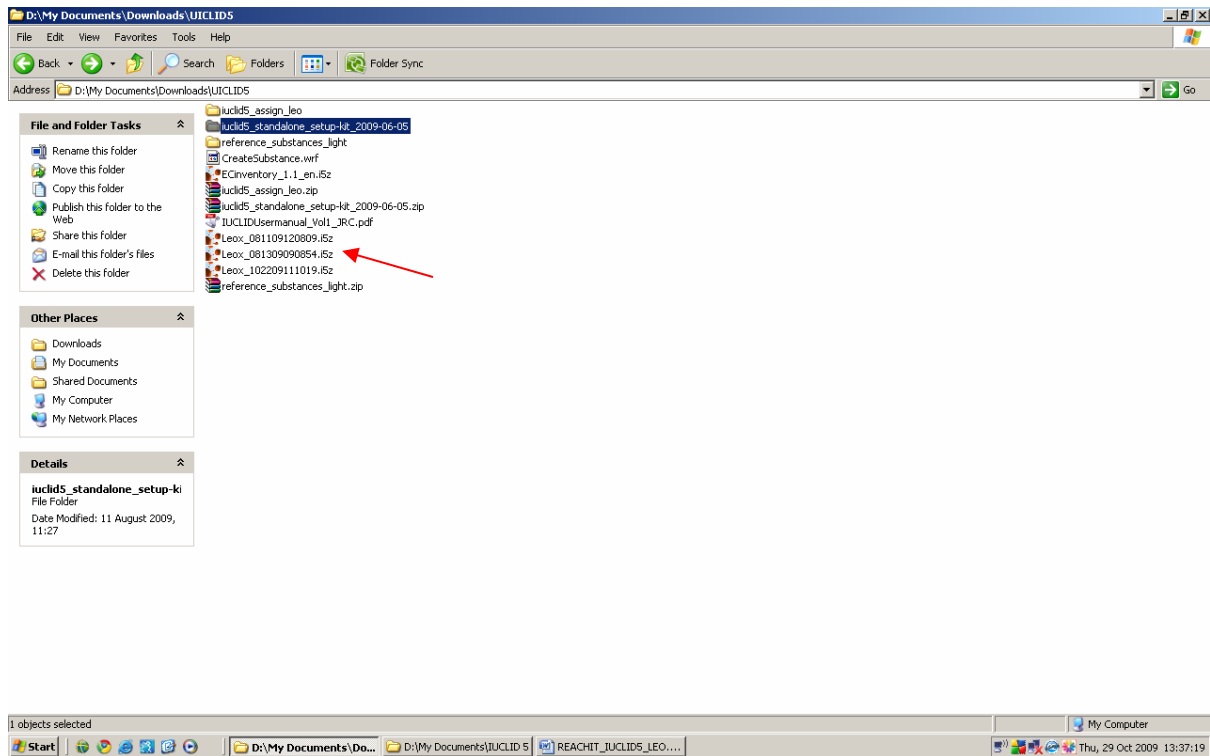
7 – Click on ‘Save’ in the box that pops up.



SAVE your LEO in your computer somewhere that you will find it easily. ‘Desktop’ is a good place.



After downloading, the LEO becomes a LEOX file.



Now your LEOX from REACH-IT is an electronic file in your computer, and is ready to be imported into IUCLID5.
